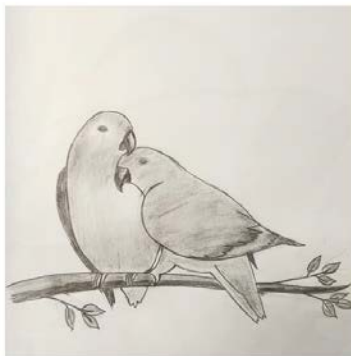

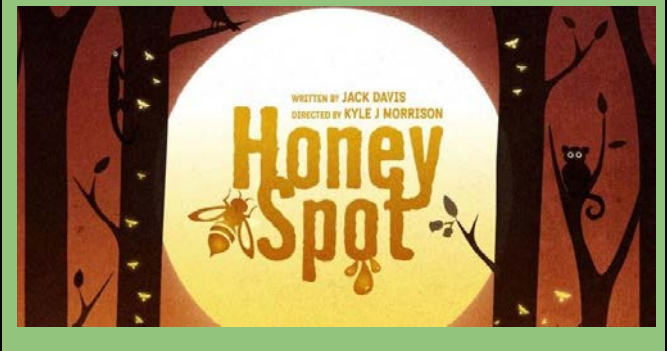

Shudiksha and Diya from 63 were the MCs of Harmony day fashion parade.

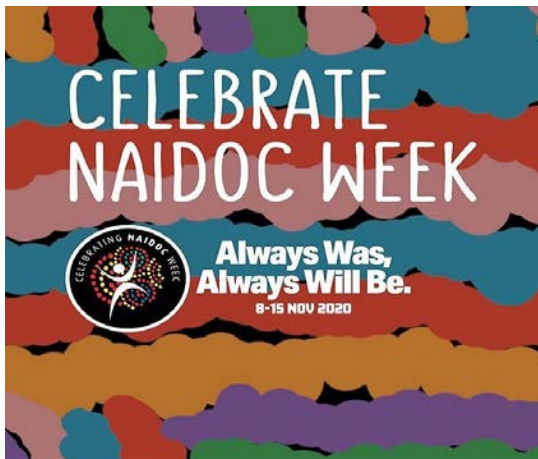


NAIDOC Week and Autism Awareness Day

What is COVID-19?

Covid-19 or Coronavirus is not just a simple virus that can be treated easily like fever. This virus can be anywhere, it can be in the air or in the things or surfaces that you touch. Mathew Brady was born in 1799 in Great Britain, England with Irish parents. He has no exact date of birth. He was quite well educated and an excellent horse rider.

On Apr 1, 1820, at the age of 21 years old, Brady was sentenced to transportation for seven years. Brady was convicted because of stealing a basket of butter, sugar and rice that had a value of 5 shillings. He tried to escape and hid on a ship going to England and before sailing, he was caught and jailed. Brady was to be transported to Australia in Van Diemen's Land and also known as Tasmania.

On Jan 1, 1823, Brady was sent to a penal colony in Macquarie Harbour, Tasmania, which is situated on the West Coast of Tasmania. On Jun 1, 1824, Brady escaped with 13 other convicts on a whaleboat. They reached the Derwent River and started the life of a bushranger.

On Jun 1, 1824 to Apr 1, 1826, Brady and his gang roamed Tasmania as bushrangers and fought a number of battles. After two years, on Apr 1, 1826, Brady was captured near Launceston, Tasmania and shot in the leg. Brady stood trial and he pleaded guilty so was sentenced to death.

On May 4, 1826, Brady was hanged at Hobart goal, Brady's body was buried in Hobart, Tasmania.

The local people supported him for his actions. His cell was filled with flowers brought by the women of Hobart Town that symbolized a "Gentleman Bushranger," because he never robbed or insulted women.

Biography of Mathew Brady

Varun Bhoominathan 43

Brady was born on Jan 1, 1799 in Great Britain. He was born to Irish settlers in Manchester, where many of the Irish people went to work during that period. He was quite well educated and was an excellent horse rider.

On Apr 1, 1820, he was sentenced to transportation for seven years to Australia. In Australia, he was sent to Van Diemen's Land (now known as Tasmania). He was sentenced for stealing a basket of butter, sugar and rice, which valued five shillings. He was sent to a family in Tasmania and worked for them. The family took good care of him.

He became a bushranger because he tried to go to England by hiding on a ship, but before sailing, he was caught and put him in prison. He tried again to escape from jail and could not escape.

After he was caught on Jan 1, 1823, he was sent to a penal colony in Macquarie Harbour, Tasmania. He escaped from the jail again in June, with 13 other convicts on a whaleboat and reached the Derwent River. He robbed a settler and started life as a bushranger.

From Jun 1, 1824 to Apr 1, 1826, he and his gang roamed Tasmania as bushrangers. They fought a number of battles with government troops and with settlers. His gang increased in size and so the rewards for his capture.

Finally, he was captured by a shot of bullet in his leg and was sentenced to death. He stood trial, near Launceston, Tasmania on Apr 1, 1826. Afterwards on May 4, 1826, he was hanged in Hobart and his body was buried at Hobart, Tasmania.

He was more popular with the local people, especially with women. They supported him because he was so genuine to them and never robbed or insulted women. They claimed him to be a "Gentleman Bushranger" and they filled his cell with flowers after he died.

Early life

Ragnar Lothbrock was born in Denmark around 795 AD to Sigurd Randversson and Alfhild Randversson. He was the only son, so he was treated very well by his parents. He grew up in a good household. At a young age, he was already trained to be a future Viking. In 816, He was sailing around Norway with some Vikings. Eventually, they came across Norway and in that time he met Aslaug "The Warriress".

Until then, he spent his time with Aslaug during his time in Norway. Before leaving Norway in the late 816 he decided to marry Aslaug. After a year, in 817 they had a child name Sigurd "Snake in the eye".

Early Actions

When he got done doing those things he made up his mind and decided to leave Norway to attack England in 820 with his fellow Vikings. They succeed in attacking England. Afterwards, they stayed in England in 820-822 to plan their next raid. Without a warning they suddenly attacked Scotland in 823. At that point Ragnar ruled Scotland from 823-825.

Later Life

After all of those things he did he went back to his family in Norway around 825. After that, in 828 Ragnar made the choice to settle in Denmark alongside his family. After being settled in Denmark Aslaug wanted more kids but Ragnar didn't want to have kids, but after being convinced by his wife they decided to adopt 2 boys who are in their teens. They adopted Bjorn Ironside and Ivar the Boneless in 830. Three years later, while they were growing up to be adults Ragnar made them train to be a Viking warriors. Once the 2 boys were ready they went somewhere in 836 to raid with Ragnar Lothbrock, Sigurd "Snake in the eye" and some Vikings.

Later Actions

In 338-340, Ragnar with his 3 sons and the Vikings sailed around the world to look for new places to raid and attack. But they didn't find a new place so they headed back to Denmark in 840 to rest and take a break. After taking a year break he went back to raiding and attacking countries. When he was done attacking the countries that he planned to attack. In 842 he went back to the water and tried to find new land. But he didn't find new lands in 843, so he decided to go back to his family again. A year later, He went back to England because it has been a long time since he has not been there. So he explored England and he thought to himself so many things have changed.

Death & Legacy

Suddenly, Ragnar got killed in England around 845. His cause of death was being thrown into a pit of venomous snakes. Soon after his death his sons took over his legacy.

Mary Reibey



Mary Reibey was born on the 12th of May, 1777 in Lancashire, England. She was orphaned at an early age and her grandmother took care of her.

Mary had a good education at Blackburn Grammar School, she attended church regularly. In 1790, her grandmother died when she was just 14 years old. She tried to steal a horse and was arrested, at that time she disguised as a boy and identified herself as James Burrows to escape punishment.

Although she escaped many times, she was caught. In the late eighteenth century, she was spared

by hangman's noose, instead she was sentenced to transportation to Australia and she arrived in New South Wales in October, 1791.

On 7 September, 1794 she married Thomas Reibey, he was an Irish free settler. They did business together then, they had 7 seven children including 3 sons and 4 daughters. She helped her husband with his shipping business.

Mary's husband died in 1811, Next couple of years Mary expanded her business by buying numerous farms in Hawkesbury River and opened a warehouse in George Street. She decided to run other businesses by herself in a short period. A year later, two of her daughters returned to Sydney and bought more properties.

Mary was active in church, education, and charity until she died in Newtown Sydney in 1855.

This is a true rag to riches story, Mary was an influential woman and her photo is on the 20 Dollar Australian note.

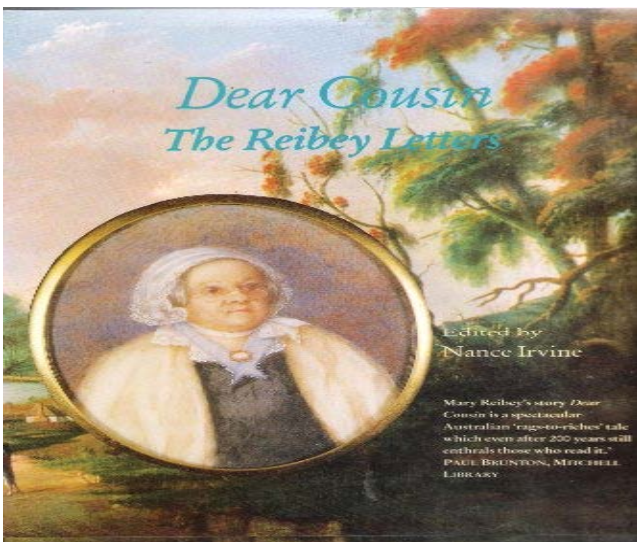

Overfishing is removal of fish from water more than what is necessary which means catching too many fish at once.

Some places and countries that are affected by overfishing are China, Japan, USA, Indonesia, Korea, Tuna, and Pacific ocean. The United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization informed that 33.1% of world fish are subjected to overfishing.

Deforestation

Deforestation refers to the decrease in forest areas across the world that are lost for uses such as agricultural croplands, urbanisation, or mining activities and it is the action of clearing a wide area of trees.

The agents that bring about deforestation include slash and burn farmers, commercial farmers, cattle ranchers, livestock herders, loggers, commercial tree planters, and firewood collectors.



Since the 1970s, deforestation is happening in southeastern Queensland and northern New South Wales, although Victoria is the most cleared state. Today, degradation is occurring in the largely forested tropical north due to rapidly expanding invasive weed species and altered fire regimes.

Direct causes of deforestation are agricultural expansion, wood extraction, logging, mining, climate change, overpopulation, wood harvest for domestic fuel or charcoal and infrastructure expansion such as road building and urbanisation.

The impact / consequences of deforestation are loss of trees, climate change, desertification, soil erosion, fewer crops, flooding, increased greenhouse gases in the atmosphere and host of problems for indigenous people.

There are some strategies / ways to manage and improve sustainability of deforestation. For example, plant trees, use less paper, buy certified wood products, reduce meat consumption, do not burn firewood excessively and recycle paper and cardboard.

In conclusion, deforestation is very harmful to the community and to other communities around the world. People should ensure forests remain healthy and diverse for the future of animals and humans.

During the War:

Children's education suffered and most schools were damaged or destroyed and used for the war proposes. This caused a shortage of suitable places to teach lessons and was not safe for them too. During the warm months' lessons could even be held outdoors. Some girls in England took part in open-air sewing classes.

Joining in war:

There were many air raids during the War, so they were building shelters for children's safety, they were not allowed to go outside their house or school while there was an air raid. 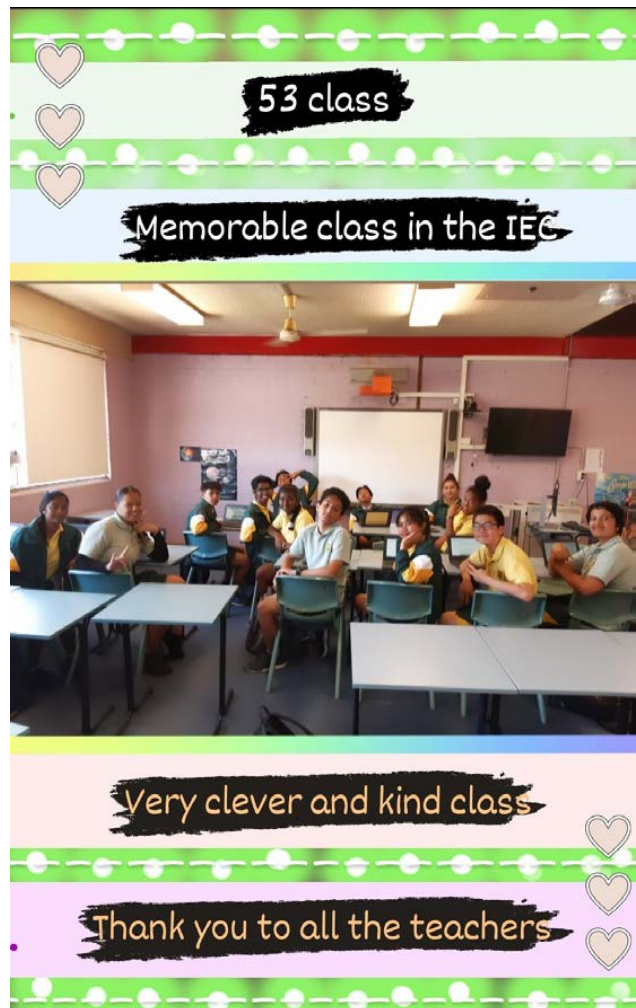

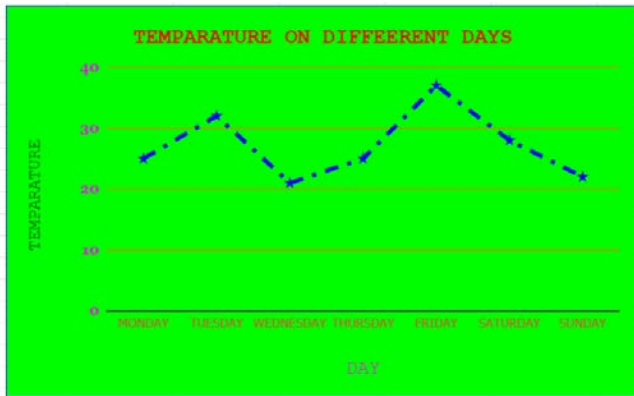
A Night of Tragedy

I celebrated my birthday on the 16 of January last year. My parents wanted to celebrate my birthday with my Aboriginal family friends in the bush, they are like our family.

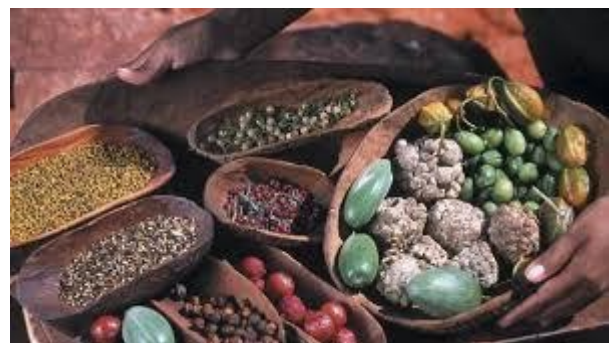

John Kelly

Biography

John Kelly early life in Ireland. John was born on 20 Feb 1820 in Moyglass Church in the county of Tipperary, Ireland. He lived near the town of Clans Brogan with his parents Thomas Kelly and Mary Cody. In 1840, John Kelly was working as a ranger on Lord Ormonde's Killarney estate and on 4 December 1840, he stole two pigs from a James Cooney of Ballysheehan.

On 1 January 1841, John was sentenced to 7 years transportation for pig stealing. On 31 July 1841 he got free from jail. Then, he embarked on the convict ship in the port of Dublin. On 7 August, they sailed from Dublin with 181 convicts on board and on 2 January 1842 they arrived in Van Diemen's Land.

After that, John went to Victoria and he met James Quinn the father of Ellen Quinn. John and Ellen got married on 18 Nov 1850 in Victoria's first Catholic Church, "St. Francis Church". Despite John being 30 and Ellen only 18.

In 1854, John bought 40 acres of land with some buildings on it at Beveridge. Later he bought 1/2 an acre in the town and built a house for renting and they had 9 children, Mary Jane Kelly, Ann (Kelly) Gunn, Edward Kelly, Thomas Kelly, Margaret Mildred Kelly, James Kelly, Daniel Kelly, Catherine Ada (Kelly) Foster and Grace (Kelly) Griffiths.

In 1858, John was able to buy another 1/2 acre and. In February 1859, he bought 21 acres and 2 small town blocks for £70. In January 1864 the family moved to Avenel near Nagambie where John rented 40 acres. On 29 May 1865, John was charged with stealing a calf.

After that his health was very bad from heavy drinking. After his 4 months in jail John died on 27 Dec 1866 because he succumbed to severe Edema.

Another way to help the forest environment is to stop deforestation and increase afforestation, Also limit clearance for agricultural habitation and encourage forest preservation through setting forest reserves.

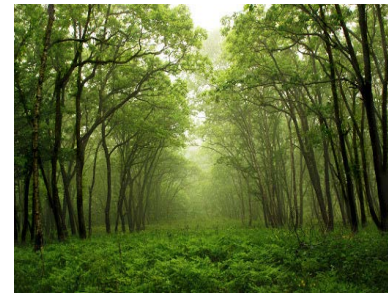
Forests are important for a healthy environment. They protect soil, provide habitat for wildlife life and clean the air by absorbing carbon dioxide.

habitat fragmentation and cut down trees for agriculture and other developments.

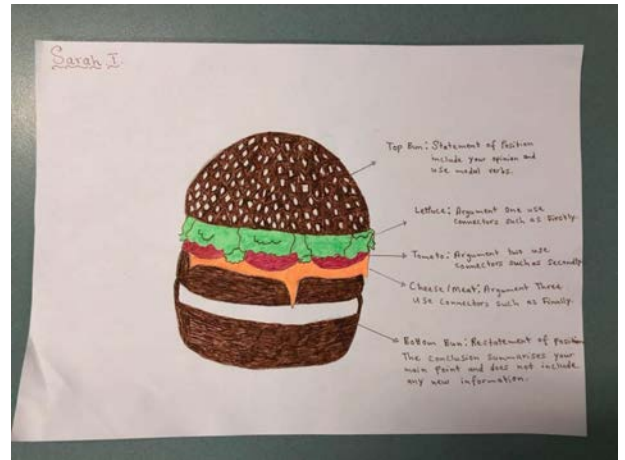

The forests are very important environments. People must protect and take care of the forest because it benefits them and helps live.

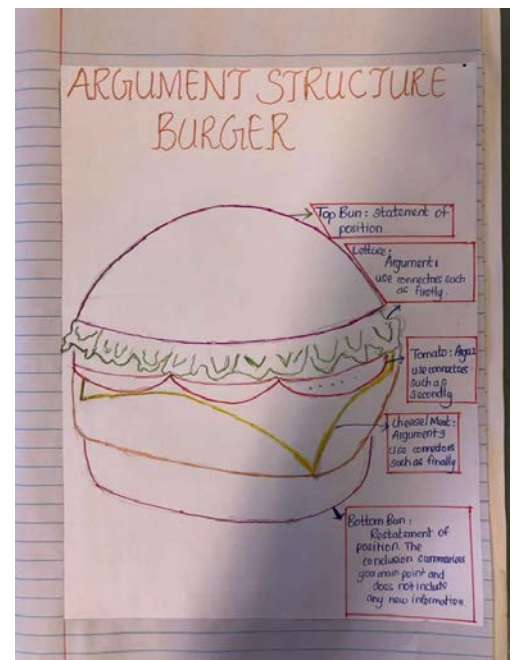
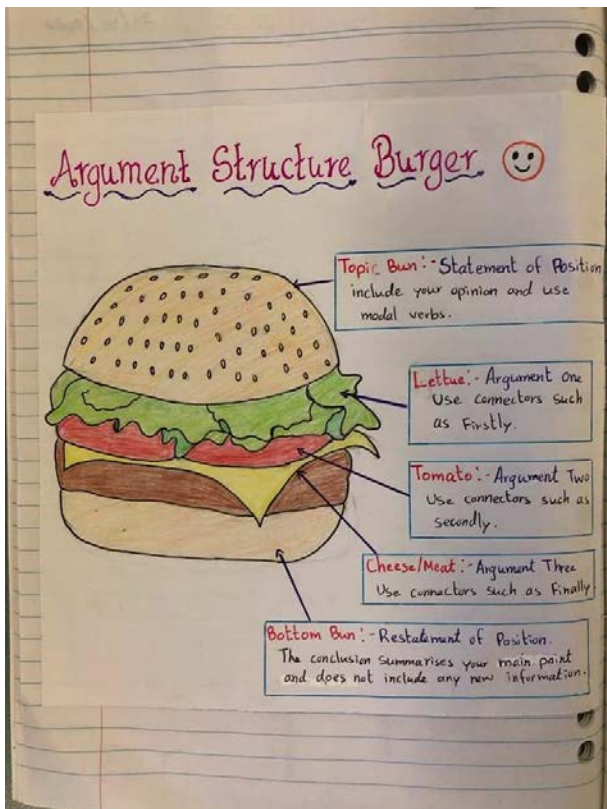

Korea in WW2

How did Japan take control of Korea?

Between 1910 and 1945, Japan worked to wipe out Korean culture, language and history.

In 1905 Korea was declared a Japanese protectorate. After five years on 22 August 1910, Korea annexed into Japanese borders with the Japan-Korea annexation treaty. Later in 1930 Korea was also allowed to develop its mining and heavy industries for the Japanese military. In 1932 Japan established the puppet nation of Manchukuo in northeastern China.

Start of WW2 in Korea

In 1937, WW2 began in Asia with the start of the second sino-Japanese war. Then by 1938, The Japanese Army opened its doors to Koreans. Korean members of the Japanese Army initially served in Manchukuo in anti-insurgency roles, but their involvement grew rapidly. In 1939 the Japanese labor force became inadequate as the war in China required more and more manpower, thus Koreans began to be recruited to work in mainland Japan, later the war many Koreans were forcefully migrated to Japan to work as laborers.

Later, on 9 December 1941, the Korean government-in-exile in Shanghai, China declared war on Japan and organized Korean volunteer units to fight the Japanese under Chinese nationalist and Chinese Communist banners. After one year in 1942, Japan's national mobilization law was extended to include its subjects in Korea. In 1943 all Korean males who were not already working in war-related industries were required to enlist in the Japanese army.

Between 1937 and 1945, 341 Koreans served in the Japanese army and 22,182 of them were killed. A large number of Korean women were conscripted as comfort women who served in Japanese military. Also, in 1945, Koreans in Japan and Korea were encouraged to abandon their Korean surnames and adopt Japanese-style ones. About 9.6% of Koreans had done so, and not all of them restored their Korean surnames after the war. By the end of the war, about 2,000,000 Koreans were living on the Japanese home island, about 1,340,000 of them returned to Korea by 1946 and about 650,000 stayed in Japan.



Yang Kyoungjong is the name of a supposed Korean soldier who, according to some historians, fought in the Japanese army, the Soviet Red Army and later the German Wehrmacht during World War 2.

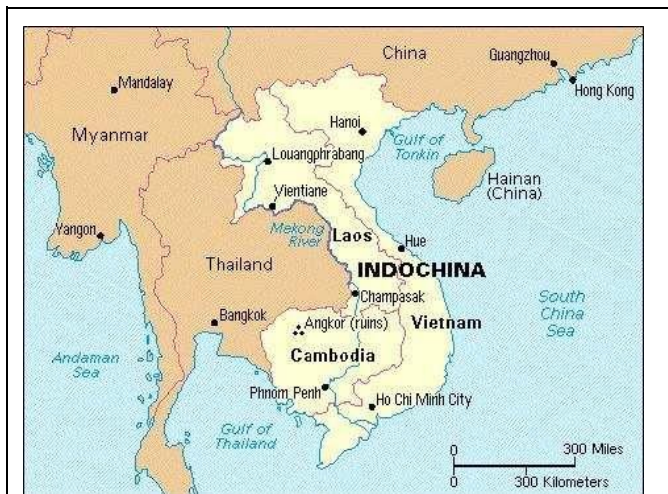


Thailand in WWII

How did Thailand join World War II

At the beginning of the war when it broke out in Europe, September 1939, Thailand declared its neutrality. However, Thailand started to join the war after France surrendered Indochina to Japan in September 1940. The reason was, the Thai president at that time known as Pibulsonggram saw the high opportunity to retrieve the territories in Cambodia and Laos.



Indochina

Indochina or French Indochina were the three countries in Southeast Asia which were French territories. There were Vietnam, Cambodia and Laos.

Franco-Thai War

The battles of French and Thai. In October 1940, there were battles between French and Thai known as Franco-Thai War in Vientiane in Laos, Sisophon, and Battambang in Cambodia. Unlucky for France, that their Air force equipment was outdated and could not adequately defend against Thai attacks which led them to defeat. Nevertheless, the situation turned out to be victorious for France in early 1941. The Japanese interfered and negotiated a peace with the French which as a result, the Laotian and Cambodian territory would be turned over to Thailand.

The Japanese possession

After Japan decided to capture the European territory in Southeast Asia, they could see the easiest way to invade Southeast Asia countries by using the independent country, Thailand. On 7 December 1941, the Japanese presented Thai government with an ultimatum to permit the Japanese troops to use their land. One hour after the Japanese had no response from Thai government, they violently attacked the coast of Thailand by using an amphibious vehicle.

Thailand declared war

On 21 December, Thailand and the Japanese Empire used to have an armistice and military alliance treaty. Consequently, on 25 January 1942, Thailand declared war on the Allies and it was also because the British tried several air strikes against the Japanese military position. Four months later, the brave Thai Phayap army expeditionary crossed and engaged China.

TONGA IN WW2

How Tonga was involved in the Solomon Islands Campaign.

Early in the 19th century Tonga became a Nation, through the military conquest under Tupou the first.

Later on in the 20th century in Tonga's case the state was entangled with the British Empire. Therefore, when the TDF was formed it was made according to the British standards in order to fight under the US as well as the military leaders.

Later in the month of September 3rd, 1939, Tonga declared war on Germany. Later on in the following year on March 15, 1940, the first Allied plane landed in the airfield in Tonga .

On June 26, 1941, the assembly opened address to the 41st legislative session. Throughout the year on December 7, the air naval bases in the Pacific were constructed by Japan and the Allied forces. On the same day the Tongans were deeply committed to the British war. On the following day on the 8th of December Tonga declared war on Japan.

Throughout the year 1941, Premier Tungā Mailefihi suddenly passed and that was the same year Japan took control of the northwest Pacific and started capturing the South.

In January 1942, the Japanese military started attacking the Solomon Islands. Throughout the year in March, Japan occupied the northeast coast of Papua New Guinea and also they also started to occupy Vietnam, Cambodia as well as Laos.



On March 3 1942, the U.S occupation took effect on Tonga. In July the following month in July the Japanese completed construction of an airbase on Guadalcanal. In August the U.S sent Marines to Guadalcanal to destroy the Japanese air base. In the same year New Zealand took responsibility for the South Pacific Area. Also the Treaty of Protectorate between Tonga and British began.

The treaty of an assault seemed imminent between Fiji and Tonga started from 1941 and ended in 1942. In April 19th 1943, they landed on Guadalcanal. From August 1942 to December 1943 the campaign began.
